Hi Everyone,

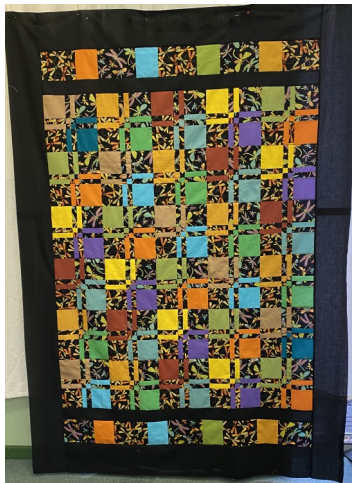
We are getting closer to the end of the year which hopefully means life for us all is slowly getting to a point of where it is more "normal" again.
