Dec Update.

Hi Everyone,

With another year behind us, I wonder if you finished your projects from the Row by Row challenge.

As you know I had already finished 2 earlier in the year (pictured below), however I am happy to report I did finish my gingham and lace quilt by the end of Dec. →

I did change my mind a few times, but finally decided on the extra row of a 4 patch in different colours, and I embroidered the same shaped butterflies as I had in my framed row. For the other extra row on the bottom, I made different coloured nine patches the added a lace strip and alternated the layout across the row.

I added the navy sashing & inner border and decided on a plain white final border rather than a navy as I first thought, or gingham in some way. So now the binding will be a navy gingham.

As I write this I am pleased to say I have gifted 20 quilts to the Mater Refugee Health unit prior to Xmas, and this week another 9 quilts to Rise Up, a DV support organisation, with another 9 ready for DV Connect

when they come back on line next week, so I would like to thank everyone who has gifted either a completed quilt, fabric or wadding, and those who have helped with the making and the quilting, to make this all possible. Since starting the gifting with Life 2 Project 3 years ago, I have moved over 150 quilts to various worthy areas, and unfortunately there are always those needing the physical and emotional support, so any assistance I get, helps me provide some comfort and everyone benefits.



These were the earlier 2 quilt tops which I finished completely before the end of the year.
