Hi Everyone,

April was a busy month with Easter and Anzac Day celebrations and in some states we have the long weekend to start May.

I have been fortunate to have had 2 trips to Adelaide in April, so I was busy early to get my challenge completed this month

For the "grey" quilt I chose to do the "Shoo Fly" pattern as 6" blocks for my connection row and repeated the row, reversing the colour placement to give balance. I kept the grey theme as the background using some left overs from a quilt my daughter Natalie had made.



For the other quilt I firstly changed the brown border I had on my January row to an aqua as it fitted better with the rest of the quilt's brighter colours. I then decided to use simple squares from the fabrics in the earlier rows, joining them so the yellow forms a zig zag through the connecting area. I repeated this so I was able to join all the rows.

For this quilt the centre is almost what I need it to be so with the May theme I will aim to complete the centre ready for some simple borders.

I hope you have had fun with your April theme of Simple connections.
