## April 2021 - Row by Row Quilt

Theme this month: Simply Connected

Hi Everyone,

I am trying to be a little organised as we head into the end of March and our Easter holidays.

I know I will not get any quilting done, however this may be the perfect time for you to spend working on a quilt, so I have decide to release this theme a week earlier than I would normally.

Depending on the depth of the rows you are making, you may be needing to get an idea of how many rows will make your quilt (as I do for one of my quilts) and to do that it makes sense to me to decide on how you want to connect the rows you have already made.

For this month the challenge is to work out how your rows can be "Simply Connected".

You could choose to do that with a single fabric, or a couple of different colours.

Another idea would be squares from fabrics you have already used in your rows, and link them in some way.

You may prefer to make a new row of simple piecing that can be used in between all the theme rows e.g. Shoo Fly, Nine Patch, Four Patch, Flying Geese etc.







You may want to use the same connecting area between all the rows of your quilt, or you may prefer to make them different—entirely up to you.

## Keep it simple.

Have fun deciding on how you will connect you already constructed rows, and put them together.
