In June I worked only on one row as I had already finished the first quilt last month, and instead of starting a new one, I chose to do some other video work.

I have now completed the second of my 2 row by row quilts. ↘

For my "disappearing block" for June I chose to make a small size in the disappearing 9 patch system (bottom row in the quilt) and with the extra "connecting" row of my Shoo Fly blocks, my quilt centre was large enough to simply add the final green border.

I have now quite a collection of tops that need to be quilted. I will have to work hard to allocate the time to get some of these now completed ready to gift on.

If you are anything like me your stash will not have changed much since the start of our monthly challenges, however I do have a lot of fun playing with ideas and seeing the finished quilts take shape.
