I used white as a background in each block, then had a check and 2 plains, one to tone with the check & the other a contrast.

I made the first block with the contrast on the edge, then the next one used it in the centre, and preferred that look. I made the last one the same way as the first to balance my row.



Throughout this month I have been fortunate to have my sister visit from S.A. (second attempt this year) and we enjoyed several quilting days, family time and even made a trip to Toowoomba for Festival of Flowers & really enjoyed being able to go to a live quilt show.

Betty was working on 2 quilts while here, and I made a smaller sample of one of them after she went home — I call it Tessellated Kimonos —this one I will add to my collection of small quilts called Timeless Treasures.

I have quilted a couple of quilts from my gifting pile as well this month, and have prepared several more ready for stitching, so I feel it has been a rewarding month.
