I have not yet been able to get to my city studio, but I understand it has been spared this time (we did get 2011 and that meant major re build etc,) so I have been in this before and my heart goes out to those dealing with it again, or for the first time.

For February's challenge I chose to add top and bottom borders to an ABC panel, and with that done, I had the leftovers, so made a smaller block quilt and I used the cut off pieces from the first parallel geese corners to make the new blocks using half square triangles.



I made the second quilt during the rain event to help give me a focus while at the farm, not knowing what was happening in the city.



I have seen some other works in progress using this block and it is always wonderful to see how different the quilts end up with different colour choices.

I hope you are having fun playing along with what is in your stash, whether it is using the ideas presented or using this as an idea for inspiration of your own design..
