or scrappy.

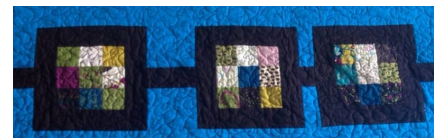


What if you used different dimensions of a nine patch in the one border?

Can you turn it on a twist, or spread them out with something in between.
