



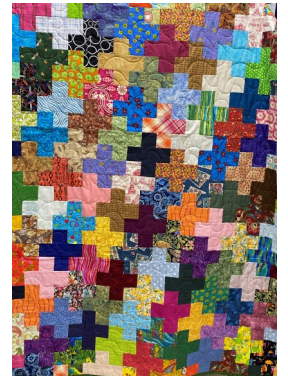
## From Cupboard to Creativity Project

July 2022 - Blocks that link with secondary patterns

### Block this month: Four Plus

Hi Everyone,

I have decided for this month to play with a much simpler block. I have made whole quilts with the → interlocking + symbol before, but decide to create a block with a background area with them. Your quilt will look different depending on:

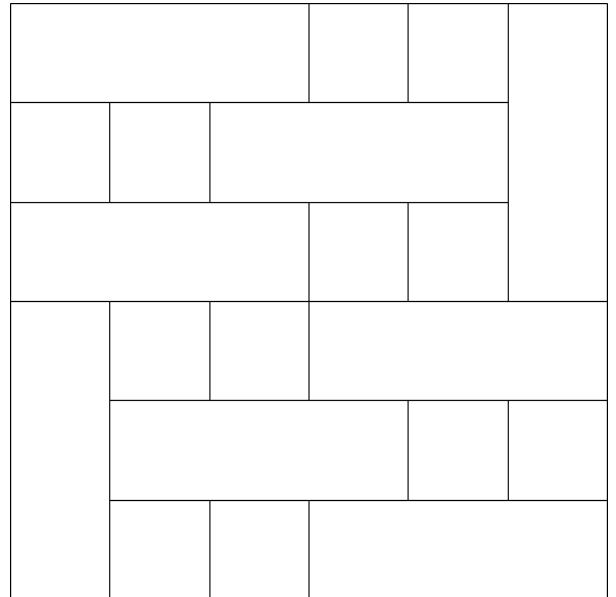


1. Your quilt layout — try with or without sashing, along with turning or not turning blocks,
2. The fabrics you use- repeatable colours the same in all blocks or each block separately coloured which can all give quite a different end result.

Here I have provided the basic outline of the block.

#### You will need for a 12" block:

1. 4 + fabrics and from each cut 2 squares of  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " and 1 strip of  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".
2. For the background you need 1 square of  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " and 1 strip of  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " per corner—they could be all the same, or change some for an interesting results —see page 2 for ideas.



#### For a 6" Block:

Substitute in 1 & 2 above squares for ones that are  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " cut and strips of  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".



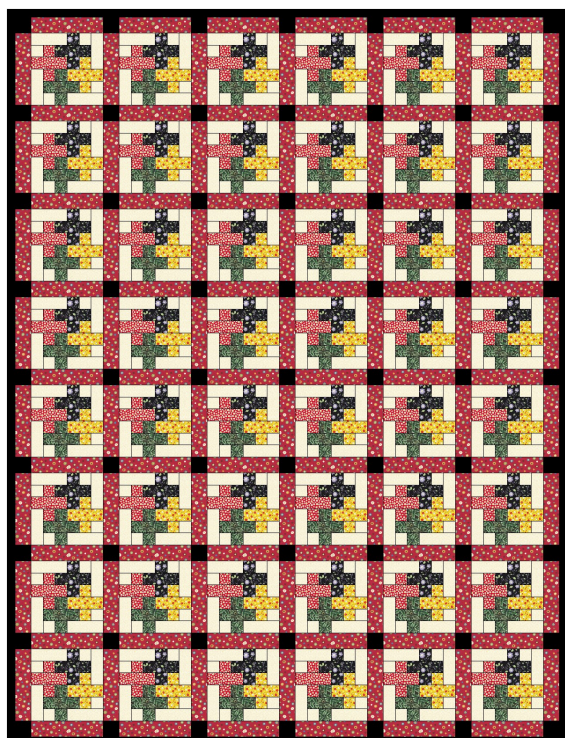
## From Cupboard to Creativity Project
