Hi Everyone,

I hope with our cooler weather you have had time to do some quilting.

I had fun with the June block—I found a Japanese designed panel and matched some fabrics to that for the blocks.

The panel was long and thin, so I cut off the top & bottom and added that to the sides to create a square (equal to 4 of the blocks), so I could use it as a centre piece.

To hide the seams, I added some Sashiko and applique, and I am really happy with the result. I will at some stage add to this and make a larger bed quilt—it currently measures 48" square.

In this photo you can see Barb's samples for April, May & June — she has decided to create rows each month.

I love the different coloured blocks for June and can imagine a whole quilt made that way.

Remember that these challenge ideas are to get you started, to create a look of your own and to help you work with what you have in your stash, and by sharing your ideas you may spark an idea for someone else.
