After I had finished I realised the fabric I had used around the edges could have been used as the background instead of the more beige piece, and the blocks would have been more clear, however I am happy with the result for the purpose for this quilt, and because it was such a fast block to do, I will make another in this pattern at some point.

I hope you have had fun playing with this simple block.
