You will notice that the alternate corners are a different colour when using an even number of squares. In the quilt lay the blocks so the corners are the same way up.
If using the 9 square option (or any odd number) all
 corner squares would have been the same fabric.

I hope you have had fun playing along throughout the year, and that you now have added to your bank of ideas to use in future quilts.
