## Quilt Ct nerpy Love Quilt-10" Letters

Finished size of blocks is $10^{\prime \prime}$ in quilt

- $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " including seams.

This would allow 1" (cut $1 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ ) between the letters in a row with $2 \frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime}$ finished border $=50^{\prime \prime}$ wide quilt The rows would need to have 2" (cut $2 \frac{1}{2}^{\prime \prime}$ ) for $55^{\prime \prime}$ height (don't need all the connectors)

## To Make the L block:

1. Cut in $L$ fabrics:
$4^{\prime \prime} \times 7^{\prime \prime}$ and $4^{\prime \prime} \times 11 \frac{11^{\prime \prime}}{}$
2. Cut a background fabric:

$50^{\prime \prime} \times 55^{\prime \prime}$ quilt $8^{\prime \prime}$ square and $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$
3. On the 8 " background square measure $1^{\prime \prime}$ from the corner across to $Y$ and up to $X$, and from these two marks, cut the shape back to corner $C$, discard the wedge shape pieces.
4. Using the letter fabric 4" $\times 7^{\prime \prime}$. Cut $\frac{1}{2}$ " shape from bottom right corner \& trim the A/B edge.

5. Using the strip of background fabric $3^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$, sew to the newly cut $A / B$ edge, leaving $\frac{1}{2}$ " overhanging at top edge. Trim the top edge only level with the letter fabric edge.

6. Sew this E/F edge to the bottom of first section $C / X$.
7. Now trim the left \& right sides of your piece level with the side $Y / C \& D / X$ on your background shape.
8. Using the strip of letter fabric $4^{\prime \prime} \times 11 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$, sew onto the left side $(Y / C)$.
9. Trim along the top of the block level with the $D / Y$ edge, then using the top \& right sides as true edges, trim the block to $10 \frac{1}{2}$ "
