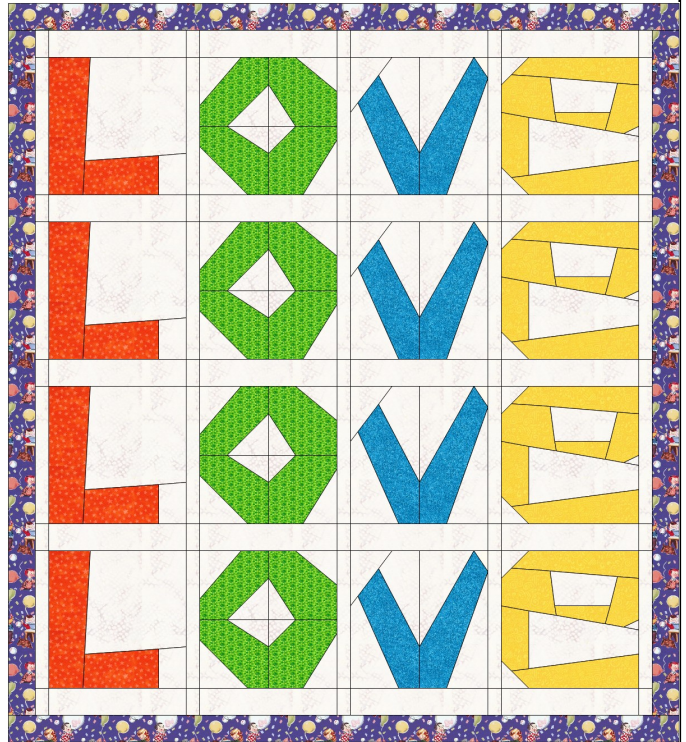


Love Quilt—10" Letters

Finished size of blocks is 10" in quilt
— 10½" including seams.

This would allow 1" (cut 1½") between the letters
in a row with 2½" finished border = 50" wide quilt

The rows would need to have 2" (cut 2½") for 55"
height (don't need all the connectors)

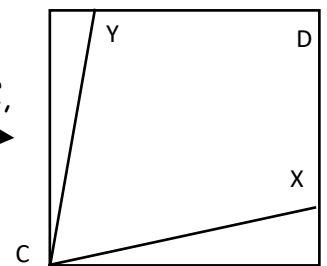


50" x 55" quilt

To Make the L block:



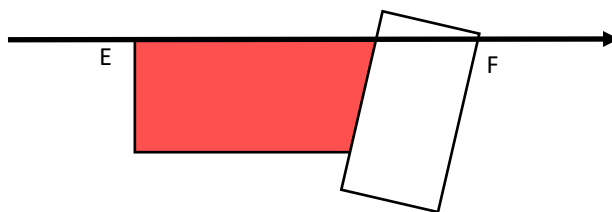
1. Cut in L fabrics:
4" x 7" and 4" x 11½"
2. Cut a background fabric:
8" square and 3" x 5"
3. On the 8" background square measure 1" from
the corner across to Y and up to X, and from
these two marks, cut the shape back to corner C,
discard the wedge shape pieces.



4. Using the letter fabric 4" x 7". Cut ½" shape from bottom right
corner & trim the A/B edge.



5. Using the strip of background fabric 3" x 5", sew to the newly cut A/B edge, leaving
½" overhanging at top edge. Trim the top edge only level with the letter fabric edge.



5. Sew this E/F edge to the bottom of first section C/X.
4. Now trim the left & right sides of your piece level with the side Y/C & D/X on your
background shape.
5. Using the strip of letter fabric 4" x 11½", sew onto the left side (Y/C).
6. Trim along the top of the block level with the D/Y edge, then using the top & right
sides as true edges, trim the block to 10½"
