## Quilltinerapy <br> Love Quilt-10" Letters

Finished size of blocks is $10^{\prime \prime}$ in quilt

- $10 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ including seams.

This would allow 1" (cut $1 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ ) between the letters in a row with $2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ finished border $=50$ " wide quilt

The rows would need to have 2" (cut $2 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ ) for 55" height (don't need all the connectors)

## To Make the O block:


$50^{\prime \prime} \times 55^{\prime \prime}$ quilt
 label as instructed below and shown in diagram at the bottom of page.
$5 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 4^{\prime \prime}$ cut on 1 diagonal, label this 1a for section $A \& 1 b$ for section D

5" square cut on 1 diagonal, label $2 a$ for section $B$, then trim the other $\frac{1}{2}$ to $4 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime}$ square \& label $2 b$ for section $A$.
$4 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$ cut on 1 diagonal label 3a for section B \& 3b for section C.
$3 \frac{1}{2}$ " square, cut on 1 diagonal, label $4 a$ for section $D$ and $4 b$ for section $C$

3. Trim the 2 corners from each of the section $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares, using the measurements shown on the diagrams. For example on Section measure from A corner 3" right \& from A corner 4" down to cut off the corner. Sew on background fabric labelled 1a.
4. Trim each of the sections and sew on the 2 triangle shapes to each as indicated in the diagrams.
5. When all corners are sewn, re-trim the squares to $5 \frac{1}{2}$.
6. Sew Section $A$ to $B \&$ Section $C$ to $D$, then join to complete the block.
