


Love Quilt—10" Letters

Finished size of blocks is 10" in quilt
 — 10½" including seams.


This would allow 1" (cut 1½") between the letters in a row
 with 2½" finished border = 50" wide quilt

The rows would need to have 2" (cut 2½") for 55" height
 (don't need all the connectors)




To Make the O block:

50" x 55" quilt



1. Cut in O fabrics: 4 squares of 5½".
 Label each one with a section A, B, C, D
 and mark an arrow to top as shown.




2. Cut the following shapes in the background fabrics,
 with right side up, cut each one on 1 diagonal and
 label as instructed below and shown in diagram at
 the bottom of page.

5½" x 4" cut on 1 diagonal, label this 1a for section A & 1b for section D

5" square cut on 1 diagonal, label 2a for section B, then trim the
 other ½ to 4½" square & label 2b for section A.

4½" x 3" cut on 1 diagonal label 3a for section B & 3b for section C.

3½" square, cut on 1 diagonal, label 4a for section D and 4b for section C



3. Trim the 2 corners from each of the section 5½" squares, using the measurements shown on the diagrams. For example on Section measure from A corner 3" right & from A corner 4" down to cut off the corner. Sew on background fabric labelled 1a.

4. Trim each of the sections and sew on the 2 triangle shapes to each as indicated in the diagrams.
5. When all corners are sewn, re-trim the squares to 5½".
6. Sew Section A to B & Section C to D, then join to complete the block.
