

## Love Quilt—10" Letters

Finished size of blocks is 10" in quilt  $-10\frac{1}{2}$ " including seams.

Please Note: Each of the background shapes when cut will create the second piece, put this aside ready for a second block.

## To Make the V block:



Part A Part B

- 1. Cut 2 rectangles of  $5\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $10\frac{1}{2}$ " in V fabric & label Part A & Part B.
- 2. Cut in Background Fabrics, with right side up to cut the diagonals:

  5" × 9" and cut on 1 diagonal for step 3.


  5" × 10" and cut on 1 diagonal for step 4.

  3" × 4" and cut on 1 diagonal for step 8.

  4½" × 5½" and cut on 1 diagonal for step 5.

  5½ × 9" and cut 1 diagonal for step 6.

  5" × 10½" and cut 1 diagonal for step 7.

## On Part A:

- 3. From C corner mark up 3" to O. From the A corner measure  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " to M, cut off the corner. Using the background fabric 5" x 9" triangle, sew it along the M/O edge, press out then trim the unit back to  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 4. From A corner measure down  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " to D & From C corner measure  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " to E & cut off corner. Using background fabric 5" x 10 triangle sew it along the D/E edge ,flip the triangle & press then trim unit back to  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 5. Mark X, 3" from A corner & Y, 4" down from A . Using  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " triangle, sew onto the X/Y edge, flip & press the triangle, then trim unit back to  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".

## On Part B:

- 6. From B corner measure 1" to F and up from C corner 3" to O & trim off corner. Using the background  $5\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$  9" triangle, & with overhang  $\frac{1}{4}$ " at F end, sew onto F/O edge , press out then trim unit back to  $5\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".

  7. Measure down from B corner 2" to G, and from C corner 2" to H, cut off corner. Using background 5"  $\times$   $10\frac{1}{2}$ " triangle, & with  $\frac{1}{2}$ " overhang at H, sew to G/H edge, then trim back to  $5\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 8. Measure from B 2" to J, and from B corner  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " to I, then cut off the corner. Using the background 3"  $\times$  4"triangle, sew onto the J/I edge, press out then retrim unit to  $5\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $10\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- 9. Sew Part A to Part B matching at O, then press seam open. Block is  $10\frac{1}{2}$ " with seams.
