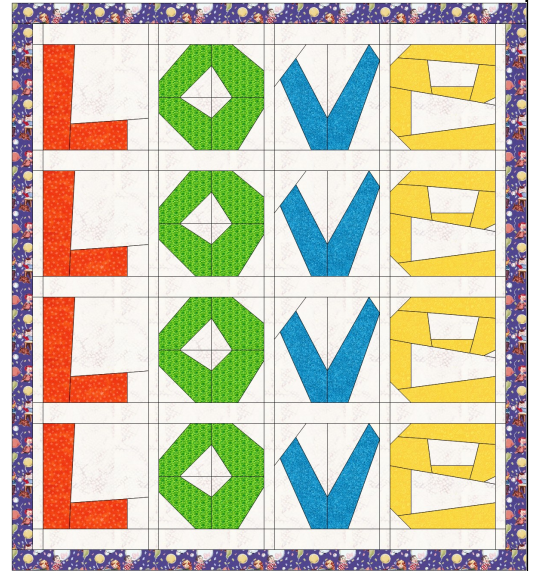


Love Quilt—10" Letters

Finished size of blocks is 10" in quilt
 — 10½" including seams.

This would allow 1" (cut 1½") between the letters in a row
 with 2½" finished border = 50" wide quilt

The rows would need to have 2" (cut 2½") for 55" height (don't need all the connectors)



50" x 55" quilt

To Make the E block (capital):

In the diagrams will indicate colour in the diagram & leave white blank

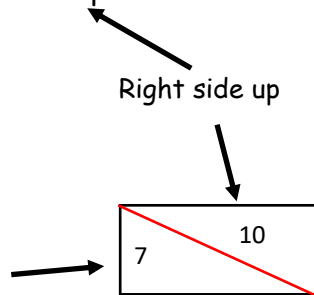
Always trim fabrics with right side up.

A. Cut in E fabric:

- 2½" x 5½" label step 1
- 3" square—label step 5 -cut 1 diagonal & discard one piece
- 3¼" x 7" label step 6
- 2½" x 6" label step 9
- 3¾" x 11" label step 12

B. Cut a background fabric:

- 2½" x 3½" label step 2
- 2¾" x 8¼" label step 3
- 3¼" x 8¼" label step 4
- 2¼" x 3" cut on 1 diagonal label step 7 & 10
- 2½" x 4" label step 8
- 3" x 3½" label step 11
- 2½" square—cut on 1 diagonal and label step 13a & b



1. Take the 2½" x 5½" letter rectangle and shape the end ½" from B to E.

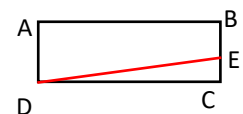
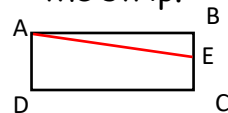
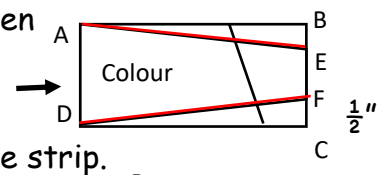
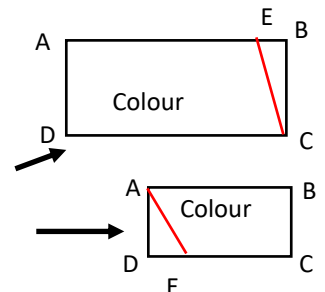
2. Take the background rectangle 2½" x 3½" and shape the end ½" from D to E. Sew this A/E side to the E/C side of previous step, then trim level with top and bottom edges of letter fabric.

Now mark on the background fabric ¾" down from B to E and from C to F and cut along A/E & F/D to wedge shape

3. Shape 2¾" x 8¼" background rectangle B to E ½" cut from A to E. & sew D/C edge to the top A/B edge of previous section in step 2, matching at right edge.

4. Shape the background 3¼" x 8¼" from C to E ¾", cut from D to E and sew this piece to the bottom edge D/C of the unit from step 2, matching at the right edge.

Now straighten the right edge of the unit level with centre section.

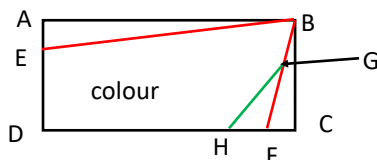
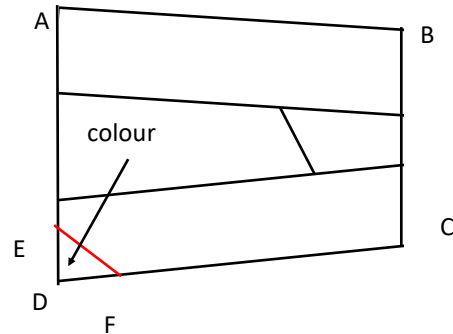

To Make the E block (capital) - continued:



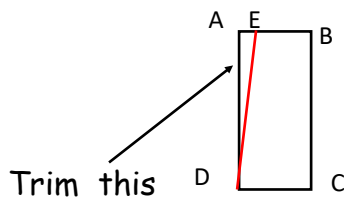
5. Mark $1\frac{1}{2}$ " from D to E & D to F & cut off the corner. Sew on the coloured triangle from 3" square. Then straighten edges level with A/E & C/F to reform the D corner.
6. Take $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x 7" colour rectangle, mark $1\frac{1}{4}$ " down from A to E, and $\frac{1}{2}$ " from C to F. Reshape piece by cutting B to E & B to F.



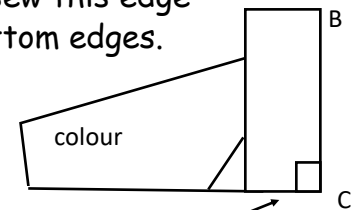
7. Now trim from the F corner — measure F to G = 2" and F to H = $1\frac{1}{4}$ ".

Sew onto the corner a background triangle marked for step 7. Reshape the corner level with colour edges.

8. Using $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4". Mark from A to E $\frac{1}{4}$ " & trim D to E, then sew this edge onto the B/F edge of your panel from step 7, match the bottom edges.



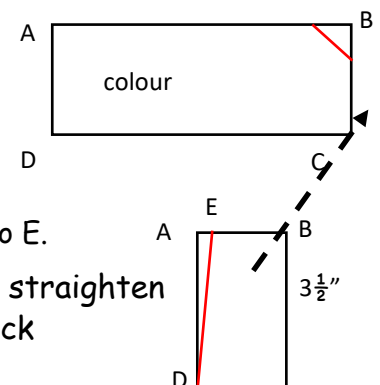
Trim this then add to right end here.



Now trim the base edge level with the colour and then form a right angle on the bottom right corner as shown in the diagram.

This is the bottom of our block, so attach it to the bottom edge of previous section from step 7, matching on the right side of the block, trim the overhang from the left side of the block.

9. Take $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6" letter fabric and trim 1" either side of B corner and cut off the corner.
10. Sew on No 10 triangle, then reshape the corner level with colour edges.
11. Take the 3 " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, mark $\frac{3}{4}$ " from A to E and cut from D to E. Now attach this to the right end (B/C of step 10) piece & re straighten level the D/C colour edges & attach this to the top of the block — we trim the A/B edge when squaring the block.

To Make the E block (capital) - continued:

At this stage place a $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square ruler over the block with $1"/1$ " corner top right and $10\frac{1}{2}$ " line on the lower edge, and straighten the right edge level with the bottom part of the E & straighten across the top of the block to form the top edge, making the block $10\frac{1}{2}$ " high.

Turn the block upside down and now trim as per the diagram.

The height is $10\frac{1}{2}$ ", the top edge (bottom of the E) is 8" and the bottom edge (top of E) is $7\frac{1}{2}$ "



12. Take the $3\frac{3}{4}$ " x 11" piece of the coloured fabric.

Sew this strip to the side of the block marked here as X.

Trim that side to make a $10\frac{1}{2}$ " square .

13. As an optional final step, a cut the top and bottom corners on the coloured side of the block, marking $1\frac{1}{2}$ " on each side of the corner and add the final triangles.

Re-square the corners to complete the block.
