I used Japanese style fabrics for the quilt, making 2 identical columns from the blocks, all with the Half Square Triangle Folded curves. I repeated the pinwheel block, changing the colours for each end of the column.



The kimono fabric completes the Japanese theme, and the quilt is finished with a black & gold border.

I hope you have had fun exploring ways to use the folded curve in your projects.
