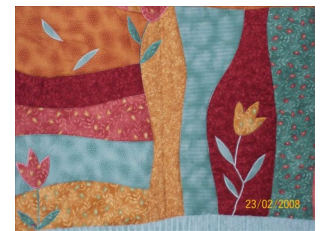
Free form Curves

I have been fortunate to have spent time with family at and near the beach over the past few weeks, firstly in Qld and now in SA, so for our October Challenge I have decided on the theme "Free Form Curves".

In my workshop "freedom", I teach a free form cutting and piecing technique and this is a section from that quilt.



In class we explore a number of ways this technique could be used in a quilt, and here are snippets from some of the student's class projects—creating blocks & row style quilts.



This month you may like to explore a landscape style project, or use the free form curves to make elements that can then be included in a more traditional design.

Considering there are different methods to achieve the curves—raw edged, folded edge & seamed to name a few, you may like to experiment this month with some sampling to use in a later project.

Here are some examples I have found of styles of free form curves used in landscapes and other forms, that may be inspiration for this month's project.
