Freeform Curves

Hi Everyone,

During October I have spent 3 weeks away with family which was wonderful, and very little time for stitching (I did manage to catch up a little on the last weekend though)

To fit with our theme for this month I managed to sew some very simple strip blocks in the same group of fabrics that I was using in September spirals, so I have put them all together to build a quilt from both challenges.

I have kept the curves gentle, using 2 per block and I have continued the blanket stitch applique method to match the spirals, but the curve blocks are machine stitched.

I managed to have enough fabrics in the jelly roll plus the couple of other pieces I was using and put together a gifting quilt. There is to be a black border to finish it and in this photo I still have 3 spirals to stitch.

This past weekend I found in a cupboard another bundle I had been gifted and managed to turn it into a quilt this month too (the centre panel was constructed) along and extra fabrics.



I hope you have found time to stitch.

For me it has been great to have a focus to keep my hands busy and my mind off all the world and local news that seems to be filled with horrible stories.

I stitch these quilts with love, knowing that when complete they will be gifted to those who need comfort, sadly that is a need that keeps on growing.
