Scrappy Weave Styles

Hi Everyone,

2024 has started out a busy one, and no doubt will continue to be, so I am making the focus for the this year to be still working through the stash, but with a zoom focus on "scraps" - those left overs that all quilt makers have by the box loads:)

For January I have chosen the theme "scrappy weave styles"

In 2020 I created a worksheet as my series of "Quilts for comfort" and used a common block used for Eye Spy style quilts and into a scrappy version shown here.

There are other blocks that we can make that will fit this same weave block but more as a scrap theme. Instead of the squares try scrappy flying geese with an extra side colour set into the block.



Here are 2 colour ideas

I have given 2 sizes for the cutting here, however have a play and change to suit your own needs.

- 1. For this block as a 6" (10") finish you would need the outer strips cut $6\frac{1}{2}$ " ($10\frac{1}{2}$ ") \times 2".
- 2. The yellow strip would be cut $6\frac{1}{2}$ " $(10\frac{1}{2}$ ") \times $1\frac{1}{2}$ "





3. The geese would be 1" \times 2" ($2\frac{1}{2}$ " \times 5") finished size

You may wish to change the geese and squares in this weaving block to something else to create your own version of a Scrappy Weave.

Have fun playing along this month.
