## Hi Everyone,

Here we are at Easter for 2024-the year seems to be going quite quickly but I am grateful I have still found time to quilt:)
With a little bit cooler weather \& even some rain this week, it has been great sewing weather.
Last moth I made a quilt for a nephew's new baby girl \& I can now share that as they have received it.


This past month I have managed to make 2 sample tops for the March challenge using the 1:2 ratio rectangles, one more traditional and the other more modern, with a third designed using all plain fabrics which is only partly constructed so I will share that one next month.

The rectangles I have used for both my designs are cut $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " and where needed to complete a row I used some $2^{\prime \prime}$ cut squares. My quilt without the border is $36^{\prime \prime} \times 54^{\prime \prime}$ however the quilt if you changed the size of the rectangles would very quickly become $48^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{\prime \prime}$ and with a couple of borders that is a single bed size. You could also add more rectangles to width or height to suit your individual needs.

I hope you have had fun playing with rectangles.
