

Cupboard to Creativity July Update 2024

Hi Everyone,

Another busy month for July and I have managed to finish my challenge sample using stripes and plains, and another top that was partly made and waiting for an extra border.

For the stripe & plain, I started with the centre blocks, cutting triangles that were the mirror of each other, then added the 4 patch using smaller versions and the gold.

With the centre made, I worked with those colours and expanded the quilt with very simple piecing including the churn dash and nine patch blocks

For the other quilt I worked on:



The centre is a panel that I had previously added some borders out to the rust.

For the new border I used the French braid concept, adding the contrast black. For two corners I framed then turned on point the print square and then added on two sides the smaller squares set in black.

On the other end I framed 3 prints and set them in gold to complete the border.

I hope you have had fun with your stripe designs too.
