We met with family I only learned of a few months ago, & we travelled from Scotland to Sommerset, visiting places where my grandparents were born, and visiting with Peter's family. We finished our trip in London where we caught up with and were totally spoilt by long time friends & did a few touristy things; like a lunch at the beach in France, for a fun day out.

Many wonderful memories were made, and a curiosity about our ancestry has begun, but for now it is back into quilting and the June Challenge.

Because I knew I would be away, I worked extra hard in May to complete the challenge for June and my Spiderman quilt was the result.

I used both a 4 patch and solid version of the blocks given. I had 2 different Spiderman fabrics, so cut them as solid $6\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and used white corner squares with black and white themed fabrics for the other frame squares.

The four patch version also used the black & white themed squares put I put black in the corner square. I set the blocks in a diagonal theme, and although a busy quilt, I'm sure a young Spiderman fan will love it.
