So for March I was able to play with the Cartwheels templates—I used the smaller size I had, and found a bag of pre cut Batik rectangles in a number of colours, so I used them as my block shape rather than re cutting them.

After I had put the top together, I thought about the river and flooding etc.

There are a couple of red patches that I may swap around before I get to the quilting or embellishing stage, something that needs a little more thought, but I will let you know how it turns out.

I managed to finish a couple of small samples for a new workshop as well, and have also been enjoying my slow stitching project, things I will share later.
