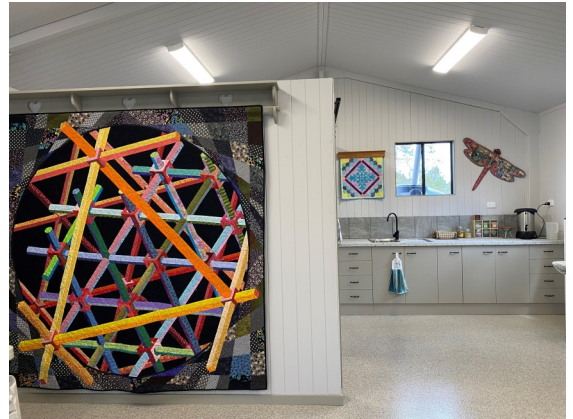


Cupboard to Creativity October Update 2025

What an eventful month this has been:-

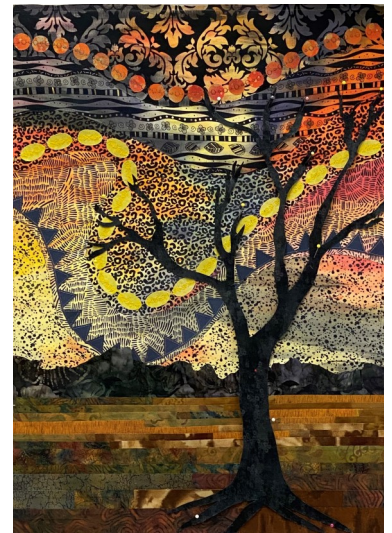
